



N.M.C. Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct applies to all members and visitors of the Northamptonshire Magicians' Club.

Members of the Northamptonshire Magicians' Club are expected to uphold the values of respect, courtesy, and professionalism at all times. Every member contributes to the friendly and welcoming atmosphere that makes our club enjoyable for all. Treat others with kindness, listen to differing opinions, and support fellow magicians in their development. Personal disagreements or disrespectful behaviour towards other members or guests will not be tolerated. Any issues should be referred to the Committee for mediation, or a complaint should be made in accordance with the rules.

During lectures, performances, and talks, members should show full attention to the speaker. Talking, interruptions, or any behaviour that distracts others is not acceptable. Eating should take place during the break, or if necessary, be done quietly and discreetly. Please ensure mobile phones are silenced, and all members are seated before the start of any presentation to maintain a professional environment that reflects well on the club.

No member or guest is permitted to film or record any lecture, performance, or presentation without prior consent from both the performer and the club committee.

Still photography is allowed for personal use and may be used to promote the club in a positive light. Images must not be shared publicly in a way that could embarrass, misrepresent, or undermine any individual or the club. Any concerns about photography or content sharing should be referred to the committee.

Members are asked to support the venue by purchasing all drinks and food only from the licensed bar. Outside food or drink should not be brought into the club. Keep the meeting area tidy, respect the staff and facilities of Brafield Working Men's Club, and take care of any club equipment or property.
